**A RESOLUTION: INITIATING REQUEST TO THE VIRGINIA
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PROHIBIT
PARKING IN FRONT OF THE TOWN OFFICE.**

WHEREAS, the Town Office is located at 53 East Colonial Highway, a public right of way owned and maintained by the Virginia Department of Transportation ("VDOT"); and

WHEREAS, vehicular parking is currently permitted in front of the Town Office; and

WHEREAS, damage to the Town Office posts and roof have occurred several times in the years between 2008-2010; and


WHEREAS, the Town's insurance carrier has requested that the Town attempt to minimize future damage by prohibiting parking in front of the Town Office; and

WHEREAS, VDOT must authorize the Town to prohibit parking on a public right of way.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Town Council of Hamilton hereby requests authorization from VDOT to prohibit parking in front of the Town Office; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Town Staff are authorized to complete the necessary documents to initiate the request.


