WHEREAS, the vigorous and wholehearted participation and dedication of the membership body is critical to the success of the commission; and


WHEREAS, William R. Gallant was appointed by the Hamilton Town Council on October 11, 1999 to serve on the Town of Hamilton Planning Commission; and




