A RESOLUTION: ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE TOWN OF HAMILTON, VIRGINIA ZONING ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Hamilton Town Council referred the Hamilton Zoning Ordinance to the Hamilton Planning Commission for comprehensive review and possible amendment in 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Hamilton Planning Commission drafted amendments to the Hamilton Zoning Ordinance; held public information sessions and public hearings on the proposed amendments; and recommended amendments to the Hamilton Zoning Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Hamilton Town Council held several work sessions on proposed amendments to the Zoning Ordinance on January 29, 2013, February 19, 2013, June 7, 2013 and July 16, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Hamilton Town Council duly advertised and held public hearings on October 15, 2012 and January 13, 2014, to receive comment on the proposed amendments.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, that the Town Council of Hamilton hereby repeals those portions of the Hamilton Zoning Ordinance that are proposed to be amended; adopts the proposed amendments and readopts the Zoning Ordinance, as amended.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Zoning Administrator, Town Attorney and Town Recorder are authorized to correct any scrivener errors in the readopted Zoning Ordinance.
