



**TOWN OF HAMILTON RESOLUTION 2014-09
HAML 2007-0002 WAIVER OF LANDSCAPING REQUIREMENT AND
SU-13-101 REALIGNMENT OF FIBER OPTIC CABLE
REFERRAL TO PLANNING COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, on September 19, 2007 the Hamilton Planning Commission approved a Site Plan including, among other requirements, landscaping installation for application HAML 2007-0002 submitted by Sprint for construction of telecommunications equipment on property owned by the Town, located at 41 S. Rogers Street, Hamilton, Virginia and identified by PIN 418-29-9026-000 ("Site"); and


WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that the landscaping if installed, may pose a security concern and interfere with the Town's ability to maintain its existing utility lines at the Site; and

WHEREAS, on August 28, 2013, the Hamilton Town Council approved Special Exception Application SU-13-101 submitted by Sprint for installation of additional equipment including a fiber optic cable; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that a realignment of the proposed installation of the fiber optic cable is necessary to avoid interference with the Town's existing utility lines.

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Council hereby refers this application for a waiver of the landscaping requirement contained in HAML 2007-0002, and an application for an amendment to the alignment of the fiber optic cable set forth in SU-13-101, to the Town of Hamilton Planning Commission for review, public hearing and recommendation. The Town Council requests that the Planning Commission return its recommendation to the Town Council by December 1, 2014.


