
**A RESOLUTION: REFERRING PROPOSED ZONING ORDINANCE
AMENDMENTS TO THE HAMILTON PLANNING
COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, a review of the Town of Hamilton Zoning Ordinance revealed that certain ordinance sections omitted the amendments previously adopted by the Town Council and several ordinance sections were in conflict; and

WHEREAS, the public necessity, convenience, general welfare and good zoning practice require that the Town of Hamilton Zoning Ordinance should be amended to address these matters; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Hamilton Planning Commission is the proper body to initially review proposed Zoning Ordinance amendments and to consider and make a recommendation to the Town Council.

NOW THEREFORE, the Hamilton Town Council hereby directs the Hamilton Planning Commission to review and receive public comment and make recommendations regarding amendments to the Town of Hamilton Zoning Ordinance, pursuant to Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended §15.2-2285.


