A RESOLUTION: SIGNIFYING THE TOWN COUNCIL'S SUPPORT TO MAINTAIN THE CURRENT POLLING PLACE FOR THE CITIZENS RESIDING IN VOTING PRECINCT 304

WHEREAS, the citizens residing in Precinct 304 currently vote at the Hamilton Baptist Church ("current polling place"), located at 16 East Colonial Highway; and

WHEREAS, the current polling place is located within the corporate limits of the Town of Hamilton and serves as a safe and convenient site for the citizens residing in voting precinct 304, including those residents who can access the current polling place as pedestrians; and


WHEREAS, it has been proposed that the current polling place for Precinct 304 be changed to the Hamilton Safety Center, located outside the Town's corporate limits and inaccessible by pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, the relocation of the polling place to the Hamilton Safety Center may lead to traffic congestion, hampered safety and inconvenience and may adversely affect the franchise rights of the citizens residing in Precinct 304.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Town Council of Hamilton hereby requests that the Hamilton Baptist Church located at 16 East Colonial Highway, Hamilton, Virginia remain the polling place for the citizens who reside in Precinct 304; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor is authorized to present this Resolution on behalf of the Town Council.


