Mayor Whitbey read the advertisement for the Proposed Budget FY 2010/2011 and highlighted some items of interest:

The proposed budget is a balanced budget.

Total Estimated Revenues \$2,064,407

Total Estimated Expenditures \$2,064,407

Proposed Tax Rates

Real Estate Tax - \$.28 per \$100 of assessed value (\$.03 increase)

Personal Property Tax - \$1.10 per \$100 of assessed value (no change)

Motor Vehicle Decal - \$25.00/automobile; \$16.00/motorcycle (no change)

Mr. Snyder noted that even though the rate for Real Estate Tax has increased by \$.03 it is tax neutral due to lower assessments.
